Vision 2020 - Weekly Leadership Report
May 11, 2018

Purpose

The purpose of this report is to provide key leaders at St. Gabriel with a written weekly update for Vision 2020. It is a non exhaustive report intended to communicate major updates and highlight appropriate high level activity. It is an appropriate and abbreviated version of what is sent to Fr Don each week.

What's Happening and Important to Know

1. Brian Audia met with Fr Don on Monday afternoon May 7th. It was a very productive time of discussion, coordination and prayer! We have a good plan in place to meet approximately once a week for the near future to continue alignment, conversation and prayer time together. Brian Audia and Pam Criss are coordinating schedules.
2. The weekly reporting structure has now been enhanced to include the Objective Teams, the PCC and the Finance Committee. They will all get the condensed version of Fr Don's weekly report after he sees it. and then it will be shared with the church in a few different ways as well. Here's the brief outline of how that will work:
 - 2.1. Brian Audia will write and send the Fr Don weekly update to Pam, Angela and the V2020LT on Friday mornings
 - 2.2. On Monday afternoons, Angela will send the update to all of the Objective Teams, the PCC and Finance Committee
 - 2.3. On Monday afternoons, Angela will also update the website with that same latest update
 - 2.4. The following weekend, Fr Don, Fr Charles and/or those making announcements will highlight any appropriate major V2020 activity in Mass in whatever way makes the most sense
 - 2.5. Printed materials for Mass will also include V2020 activity
 - 2.6. In the future, information will be available in the Narthex when that strategy is completed
3. Organizational Assessment: Completed all interviews with the exception of Deacon Mike, Father Charles and the Finance Committee. Kathleen Frye and Brian Audia will be meeting with Mike on Tuesday morning early followed by representatives from the Finance Committee.. We are working on coordinating schedules with Father Charles.
4. PCC Baseline Current State work: The Ministry Leader Survey closed with 60 responses and the ministry member survey is well underway. So far we have 400 responses! That said, keep in mind that some have filled it out multiple times since they are in multiple ministries. A reminder will go out today, May 11. We are extending the survey deadline through the weekend. The team also met to discuss where we need to go to collect hard metrics. That will begin next week!
